Eligibility to contribute

You must meet eligibility criteria in order to make a contribution to your account. Tick the appropriate box below to declare your eligibility.

- I am aged between 67 and 75 and have been gainfully employed for at least 40 hours in a period of not more than 30 consecutive days during the current financial year. Therefore I confirm I am eligible to contribute to my superannuation account.

 - who is an Australian resident between ages of 67 and 75 and has been gainfully employed for at least 40 hours during any 30 consecutive day period in the current financial year.
